Course unit contents <i>Theoretical classes</i> Basic music theory – concept of music, sound, tonal system, music notation, notes, clefs – the treble clef, the bass clef, metric system, rhythm, note and pause values, time signatures, basic scale, major and minor scales, intervals, chords, tonality, transposition, tempo, dynamics, repeat signs and repeated sections, articulations, analysis of children’s songs. <i>Practical classes</i> Accordion classes – introduction to the instrument, playing techniques, exercise of the right hand, exercise of the left hand, fingering on accordion, playing children’s songs
