Master of Arts in Class Teacher Education

Level of study program: Master academic studies, second degree higher education

Duration: Two semesters – one year, 60 ECTS

Study programme pre-requisites: Enrollment is done on the basis of an application procedure announced by the University of Kragujevac, and conducted by the Faculty of Education, Jagodina. A candidate who has previously completed relevant undergraduate academic studies (240 ECTS credits) can enroll in the second degree studies. The selection of candidates for enrollment in the study program is based on the general average grade achieved in undergraduate studies studies and the duration of previous studies.

Study programme objectives and description of the program:

The program has all the elements provided by the Law on Higher Education and standards for accreditation of Level II study programs. The type of study and the outcomes of the learning process are in line with the Law on the National Qualifications Framework of the Republic of Serbia.

The main objective of the study program is to upgrade and develop general academic and subject-specific competencies necessary for the performance of educational work in the first cycle of primary education.

The curriculum of the program contains 3 compulsory courses with total of 17 ECTS credits and 24 elective courses (of which the student chooses 3 courses), the compulsory internship that lasts 4 weeks and equates 6 ECTS credits, and the master thesis with 20 ECTS credits.

Teaching includes lectures, exercises, study and research work, tutoring lessons and supervision. Special attention is given to individual research work with students during tutoring lessons and supervision. The visits of experts, which the Faculty periodically organizes within workshops and conferences contribute to the quality of teaching.
